in 1920, babe ruth played her first season as new york yankee. showing the way for a new generation of top cutting power beaters, the published sluging numbers child the game had never seen. baseball seasons image gallerybesides hitting a cobbian .376, ruth swatted 54 home runs, which not only exceeded its 29 record but also each of the seven other teams of american league, the nearest individual batter, st. louis 'george sisler, hit 19, ruth led the slugging alloy to the .847, the highest brand registered in both leagues until 2001.
