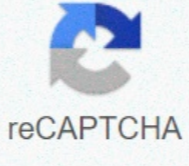

Banks had previously been working on a film adaptation of "Red Queen" going back to 2015. Other recently announced projects for Brownstone include the "Flintstones" sequel series "Bedrock" at Fox, with Banks set to voice an adult Pebbles. The company has a wide array of other projects set up at various networks and streamers around town. On the film side, their current slate includes "Invisible Woman," "Science Fair," and "The Magic School Bus," while their TV slate includes "Shrill" at Hulu and "Over My Dead Body" at HBO Max. Banks and Brownstone are repped by UTA, Untitled Entertainment, Relevant, and Ziffren Brittenham. There's an unmistakable feeling of deja vu to this first installment in the Red Queen trilogy, which shares several plot points and similarities with the Hunger Games series, with more arenas for barbaric televised slaughter and honed survival skills swapped out for preternatural powers.
