Letter R Sort In the alphabet Letter R Sort, students cut and paste the letter R based on whether it is uppercase or lowercase. A variety of fonts have been used to increase the students awareness of different text types. Red Riding Hood ABC Order This ABC Order worksheet will help children practice putting words in alphabetical order. Knowing how to put words in alphabetical order is an important life skill. The alphabet is printed on the side of the page to help with the task of alphabetizing. Children can refer to this when they are deciding which word comes next. To support children in reading the words, a picture of the fairy tale object is printed beside each word. Color by Word Family In this activity, children color Little Red Riding Hood using the 'oo' word family coloring code. Label Little Red Riding Hood Labeling and complete the sentence writing activities are great for supporting emergent writers. In Label Little Red Riding Hood, children use the word bank to label a picture of Red Riding Hood. Label the Wolf and Complete the Sentence Similarly, in the Label the Wolf activity, children label the wolf and complete the sentence by writing the missing words beneath the picture. The missing words are included in the word bank. This activity is great for children learning to describe characters from a fairy tale and getting them to practice writing descriptive sentences. Little Red Riding Hood Sentences Numerous grammar and vocabulary activities are provided in the Red Riding Hood packet. This includes worksheets such as complete the sentences. In the Little Red Riding Hood Sentences worksheet, children use the word bank to fill in the missing words and complete the sentences. This activity is great for developing vocabulary and for using as a story recall activity. Little Red Riding Hood Punctuation The Red Riding Hood Punctuation worksheet is great for reviewing types of sentences, and the correct ending punctuation for these sentences. Describe the Character: Little Red Riding Hood A variety of open-ended picture writing prompts are also included in the packet. Describe the Setting: The Forest To support children with their spelling and to give them ideas for their writing, a vocabulary word bank is included with each writing prompt. Story Sequencing with Pictures The Red Riding Hood fairy tale packet contains several story sequencing activities. A story sequencing activity is ideal for teaching the fairy tale story structure, fairy tale comprehension, and fairy tale recall skills. Children can complete a picture sequencing worksheet or a text-based sequencing worksheet. Below is the picture fairy tale sequencing activity in action. Children look at the pictures and cut and paste them in the order of the fairy tale events. Little Red Riding Hood Story Map A story map helps a child learn the elements of the fairy tale. The Red Riding Hood story map graphic organiser has 4 sections that allow the child to analyse the characters, setting, problem, and solution in the fairy tale. Little Red Riding Hood True or False Another fairy tale comprehension activity included in the packet is the Little Red Riding Hood True or False worksheet. Children read the statements about the fairy tale and decide whether the statement is true or false. This is a great way to follow up a reading of the fairy tale to make sure children remember the main events in the story. Reading Comprehension Passage: Wolves The Little Red Riding Hood fairy tale lends itself well to a study of wolves. Included in the packet are activities that explore wolves and provide children with the opportunity to compare real wolves with wolves from a fairy tale. Real and Imaginary Wolves: Venn Diagram Little Red Riding Hood Word Search Crosswords and word search activities are a fun way to review the vocabulary from the Red Riding Hood fairy tale. These worksheets can be used for morning work or homework during your fairy tale unit. Little Red Riding Hood Number Maze The Red Riding Hood Number Maze is a great activity to reinforce counting from 1-50. Children help Red Riding Hood find her way through the forest by counting from 1 to 50 and coloring the path to the cottage. Little Red Riding Hood Number Chain Puzzle In this addition and subtraction puzzle, children complete the addition and subtraction facts to complete the Number Chain. This is a great activity for reviewing addition and subtraction within 20. Little Red Riding Hood: Measurement using Inches In this Red Riding Hood measurement worksheet, students use a ruler to measure the distance between the fairy tale objects in inches.
